To be responsible for the organization, development, implementation, and maintenance of a planned program to meet the physical and spiritual needs of the Youth of our congregation

1. To organize and plan various Youth activities
2. Provide for each age group, "age appropriate" activities
3. It will be your duty to select teachers and literature for Jr. High, Senior High and Young Adults.
4. Provide programs and leadership to train our young people the necessity of proper dress (modest dress), respect for others, the ability to lead prayers, present devotionals, lead singing, serve on the Lord's Table (when they become Christians). The ultimate goal is to develop the Youth to become future Bible teachers, deacons, elders, Christian-wives and mothers and Christian-husbands and fathers.
5. To oversee and aid the continuance of the "GRITS" Program
6. Enlist the aid and support of adults in the congregation to help as chaperones or helpers as needed for Youth events.
7. Co-coordinate Youth activities with Area Churches
8. Prepare a Budget for the Youth Program and discuss with Elders
9. Meet with the Elders at least once a Month, or as often as you need to
10. Select at least one man from the congregation to assist you full time
11. Plan Youth activities well in advance so funding and other arrangements can be made prior to the event
12. Explore the possibility of Sardis Lake Christian Camp for some of our Youth this Summer. Discuss with the Elders the possibility of financial support for this activity
13. Keep accurate and consistent records of Youth activities to present to the Elders
