

HIGHLIGHTS OF WORK IN THE PACIFIC FOR 2010

1. Jan, Feb, Mar – Three trips to Tonga – two purposes
 - a. One to check on putting a container of relief on the island of Niutaputopu which was badly effected by the Sept 29, 2009 tsunami
 - b. Survey the condition of the Lord's church in the nation of Tonga
2. Jan to Mar three baptisms and 2 restorations at Leone
3. Mar / Apr – Trip into Fiji to oversee distribution of two containers of relief aid in the wake of Hurricane Tomas
4. Mar thru Oct – placed and maintained two cement mixers in villages to help with rebuilding
5. April – Robert Martin conducts a gospel meeting at Leone
6. May. PIBC – American Samoa / Jason Pierce taught "1 & 2 Peter / 1, 2, & 3 John" and Rocco Pierce taught "Joshua thru Esther"
7. Produced a new Radio Show – "My Father's World" Broadcast on KULA and KKHJ
8. Written and also produced tracts written by local brethren, printed, and distributed them
9. Tiled floor in the KULA building
10. June – Western Samoa PIBC with Ray Paseur and Scott Crockett – I went over to make sure everything was going smoothly – one baptism
11. June / July – Constitutional Convention (2 weeks)
12. July – Home for our son Josh's wedding
13. Aug – Youth Camp at Leone (Josh and Lauren came from the US to help)
 - a. 30 kids
 - b. 2 baptisms
14. Sept – Judy Walker and Kim Carver came to help sign people up for Bible Correspondence course in American and Western Samoa
15. Sept / Oct Evangelistic efforts in Samoa & Fiji – PIBC courses in Buca and Vatudamu (Pentateuch / Preparation and Delivery of Sermons).
 - a. Had to write and compile two new text books
 - b. Preached in Vaimoso & Aliesa / Conducted Bible studies in Savaii and Salesateli in Western Samoa
 - c. Worked with churches in Nadi, Naila, and Ba on the Island of Viti Levu, Fiji
 - d. PIBC in Buca and Vatudamu on the Island of Venua Levu, Fiji
 - e. Preached at Buca, Vatudamu, and Lambasa on the Island of Venua Levu, Fiji
 - f. Mission efforts to Vatudamu, and also on the remote islands of Kioa, and Rabi
 - g. 6 baptisms (5 in Vatudamu and 1 on Kioa)
